WHEREAS, Maricopa County Superior Court Local Rule 1.2 authorizes the Presiding Judge to select Department Presiding Judges; and

WHEREAS, Rule 92 of the Rules of the Supreme Court and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 authorizes the Presiding Judge to make judicial assignments;

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 specifically directs the Superior Court Presiding Judge to appoint a presiding judge of the juvenile department;

**IT IS ORDERED** appointing the Honorable Timothy J. Ryan as the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Department effective October 1, 2017 to manage the day-to-day operations and provide administrative oversight over all cases and judges assigned to the Juvenile Department, direct initial and continuing training for the Juvenile Department, and conduct regular departmental meetings. In addition, the Juvenile Department Presiding Judge shall serve as the representative of the Superior Court in Maricopa County on any statutory or non-statutory committees related to the Juvenile Department as appointed by the Arizona Supreme Court.
