WHEREAS, Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure 5.2(c)(1)(A) requires that an electronically filed proposed order “must be in a format that permits it to be modified, such as .odt or .docx or other format permitted by Administrative Order, and must not be password protected.” However, in cases involving eminent domain, certain orders must contain a legal description that often includes a map. The legal description appears in such an order as an image rather than as text; for this reason it can only be electronically filed in a .pdf format.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a form of order in an eminent domain case that requires an attached legal description of real property may be electronically lodged in PDF format.
