Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Art. 6, Sec. 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 96 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court (RASC),

IT IS ORDERED that Tracy R. Nadzieja is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, effective April 20, 2018, on a full time basis, with the working title of "Commissioner." Tracy R. Nadzieja shall serve one uninterrupted term of service, until retirement, resignation or termination.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tracy R. Nadzieja shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not be limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 96, RASC, as amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tracy R. Nadzieja is assigned to hear any matter within the purview of this appointment pursuant to law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tracy R. Nadzieja shall receive compensation at an annual salary of ninety percent of the salary of a judge of the Superior Court, which currently calculates to \$134,444.34, pro-rated for the balance of calendar year 2018. This appointment is conditioned upon the agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner while employed as a Commissioner by the Court, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when acting in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore.
