IN THE MATTER OF REDACTING VICTIMS' DATES OF BIRTH FROM LIFETIME NO-CONTACT INJUNCTIONS PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 13-719

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2023-027

The Arizona Legislature created the right of victims to request Lifetime No-Contact Injunctions pursuant to A.R.S. §13-719. The statute allows victims to request the lifetime injunction at sentencing, or if the defendant was sentenced before September 24, 2022, to file for a retroactive lifetime injunction. The Clerk of the Superior Court has advised the Court that for the Lifetime No-Contact Injunctions filed between September 24, 2022 and January 27, 2023, the victims' dates of birth have appeared on the injunctions in violation of their right to protect their identifying information pursuant to A.R.S. §13-4434.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of the Superior Court redact all victims' dates of birth from all Orders for Lifetime No-Contact Injunctions filed between September 24, 2022 and January 27, 2023. The redacted Orders will replace the unredacted Orders and serve as the original document for all purposes. All other provisions of A.R.S. §13-719 remain unchanged and in effect.
