ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Whereas, the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for qualified English<>Nuer and Arabic-Juba court interpretation, transcription, and translation owing to a demand for interpretation services for Nuer and Arabic-Juba speaking defendants, victims and witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas, the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Nuer and Arabic-Juba language interpreters and translators;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation, transcription, and translation services to judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Nuer and Arabic-Juba interpretation, transcription, and translation services. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Daniel Daniel be allowed to work as an English<>Nuer and Arabic-Juba contract court interpreter and court translator during the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
2. Mr. Daniel Daniel be compensated according to the terms and conditions of the existing court contract for court interpreters and transcription and translation services (09013-RFP / 09005-RFQ).
3. Mr. Daniel Daniel be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Daniel Daniel abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
