Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified Spanish<>Mam court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Mam speaking defendants, victims and witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Mam language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation services to judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring Spanish<>Mam interpretation services. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Marino Garcia, a California certified court interpreter, be allowed to work as a Spanish<>Mam contract court interpreter during the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
2. Mr. Marino Garcia be compensated at the rate of \$70.00 per hour with a minimum of one hour for telephonic interpreting.
3. Mr. Marino Garcia be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Marino Garcia abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
