Whereas, the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for qualified Korean<>English court interpretation, transcription and translation services owing to a demand for and a lack of availability of current Korean speaking contractors; and

Whereas, the existing court transcription and translation service vendors do not have qualified and reliable Korean language translators and interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation, transcription and translation services to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of a qualified provider. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring Korean<>English interpretation, transcription and translation services. Therefore,

## IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Miryoung Sohn, independent contractor, be able to provide Korean<>English contract court interpretation, transcription and translation during the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
- 2. Miryoung Sohn be compensated at the rate of \$0.20 per word in the target language for the transcription.
- 3. Miryoung Sohn be compensated according to the terms and conditions of the existing court contract for court interpreters (09005-RFQ).
- 4. Miryoung Sohn abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for the Court Interpreters established by this Court.
