On suggestion of the Clerk of Superior Court based upon the fact that many boxes of recordings of conversations wiretapped pursuant to A.R.S. 13-3010 are in her custody, and further, that the following listed recordings have been retained by the Clerk for more than ten years,

**IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to A.R.S. 13-3010(H), that the recordings and related materials to the CWT cases as listed on the Attachment to this Administrative Order be disposed of as follows:

1. The Clerk shall ascertain the police agency which made the recordings, and if necessary shall unseal the packages containing those recordings to do so; (NOTE: Verbal authorization was granted to the Clerk to unseal packages for this purpose on May 3, 1993 so that the Attachment listing the cases could be prepared).

2. The Clerk shall provide written notification to the agency which made the recordings to physically retrieve the recordings and any related materials from the Clerk within thirty days of the notification. The clerk shall also send a copy of the notification to the Arizona Attorney General and to the Maricopa County Attorney.

3. The Clerk avows that the required notifications to the agencies will be made, via the U. S. Mail, by May 10, 1993, and accordingly; if the recordings have not been retrieved by the respective police agencies by July 8, 1993, the Clerk shall destroy the recordings.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any CWT case listed on the Attachment for which the originating police agency is designated as "unknown" can only be retrieved by a police agency that can provide to the Clerk written documentation substantiating that the case did originate from that agency.
