For approximately the next twenty-four (24) months, it will be necessary to relocate judges from the downtown Phoenix court facilities to the Southeast Judicial facilities because of the renovation of the Old Courthouse. The current Southeast case filings will not presently support the relocated judges from the downtown facilities in addition to those judges already assigned to a Southeast case load. It will, therefore, be necessary for the judges relocated from the Phoenix facilities to continue with their regular case load assignments. It is in the interest of judicial efficiency and judicial economy that cases assigned to judges located at the Southeast Judicial Facility remain at the Southeast Judicial Facility in so far as practical;

Accordingly, it is:

ORDERED that on any Notice of Change of Judge in a case assigned to any judge located at the Southeast Judicial Facility, the case shall be reassigned to a judge located at the Southeast Judicial Facility.

ORDERED that the Presiding Civil Judge or his designee located at the Southeast Judicial Facility shall be responsible for the determination of all Notices of Change of Judge, with or without cause.

ORDERED that Maricopa County Local Rule 11.3 is hereby suspended.
