Pursuant to the Order of the Supreme Court dated December 14, 1992, appointing Court Commissioners as Judges Pro Tempore of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, and Administrative Order No. 93-004, authorizing such Court Commissioners in their capacity as Judges Pro Tempore to hear and decide matters assigned to them by the Presiding Judge, by any departmental presiding judge, or by the Court Administrator,

IT IS ORDERED assigning the following matters to the Court Commissioners assigned to the Probate and Mental Health Department of this Court for supervision, hearing, and decision in their capacity as Judges Pro Tempore:

1. The first pretrial/prehearing and scheduling conference in each matter which becomes contested on a Court Commissioner's calendar.

2. All pretrial/prehearing motions and conferences, and hearings/trials relating to matters which the Court Commissioner determines at the first pretrial/prehearing and scheduling conference are likely to require less than one day of trial time.

3. Formal probate and intestacy hearings.

4. Proceedings to change, correct, or complete birth

certificates for which case files are not opened.

5. Petitions for court-ordered evaluation, court-ordered treatment, and any other proceeding arising under Title 36, Arizona Revised Statutes.
