Pursuant to the authority of ARS 914-5303, 914-5305 and 914-5307, it is the responsibility of the Probate Court Visitors to conduct investigations in order to report on the facts of a case before the Probate Court. The duties of Probate Court Visitors include, but are not limited to: interviews of the alleged incapacitated or protected person, proposed guardian and/or conservator; visits to residences, group homes, nursing homes or hospitals; interviews with nursing or care home managers or administrators, nurses or caregivers; and accessing patient medical records or financial information.

**IT IS ORDERED** directing all persons, facilities or institutions, including but not limited to alleged incapacitated or protected persons, proposed guardians or conservators, occupants and caregivers of residences, personnel, nurses, doctors, supervisors, managers and administrators of group homes, nursing homes, and hospitals, and to cooperate fully with the Probate Court Visitors and allow access by and to supply the Probate Court Visitors with any medical and financial records and information they may request in the course of their court investigations.
