The budget deficit and crisis of Maricopa County have caused a disruption of the normal processing of matters which need action by the Board of Supervisors other than financial matters. The appointment of Justices of the Peace Pro Tempore for the term of January 1 through June 30, 1994, is one of those items. After Board action in January, 1994, the Administrative Order will appoint the Justices of the Peace Pro Tempore effective as of January 1, 1994. In the meantime, to avoid confusion and consternation, and until such Board action and subsequent Administrative Order, it is

ORDERED that all persons appointed as Justices of the Peace Pro Tempore for the term July 1 through December 31, 1993, by the presiding judge of Maricopa County on June 30, 1993, in Administrative Order 93-051 are hereby continued in that capacity until subsequent order of the presiding judge relating to Justices of the Peace Pro Tempore.
