ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 96-039

It appearing that there is good cause to amend Administrative Order 95-036, establishing per diem rates for interpreters providing services to the Court who are not employees,

IT IS ORDERED establishing rates and methods of compensation for freelance interpreters effective immediately as follows:

Level I [Qualified by the Office of the Court Interpreter to practice in all court matters (adult and juvenile)]:

- \$ 50 Appearance fee for cancellations with less than a 24-hour notice
- 100 For interpreter services engaged for the half-day
- 200 For interpreter services engaged for the full-day

- 100 For interpreter services at the Initial Appearance Court, 11:00 p.m. session
- 120 For interpreter services at the Initial Appearance Court, 4:00 a.m. session

Level II [Qualified by the Office of the Court Interpreter to practice in Initial Appearance Court, IV-D matters and out-of-court appearances]:

- \$ 40 Appearance fee for cancellations with less than a 24-hour notice
- 80 For interpreter services engaged for the half-day
- 160 For interpreter services engaged for the full-day

- 80 For interpreter services at the Initial Appearance Court, 11:00 p.m. session
- 100 For interpreter services at the Initial Appearance Court, 4:00 a.m. session

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Judge, or designee, may authorize a temporary increase in these per diem rates for periods deemed appropriate and necessary by the court to meet the extraordinary need for interpreter services by the judiciary.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Office of the Court Administrator is authorized to deviate from these rates in situations requiring the services of an interpreter for lesser-used languages.
