WHEREAS, the Mesa Municipal Court is in the process of constructing a new court facility; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Supreme Court exercises administrative control over all the courts in the state; and

WHEREAS, Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 delegates authority to the Presiding Judge of the County as follows: "Presiding judges shall determine the need for, and approve, the allocation of space and furnishings in the court building; the construction of new court buildings, courtrooms and related physical facilities; and the modification of existing court buildings, courtrooms and related physical facilities. This authority extends, but is not limited to, superior court and all of its divisions, clerk of the superior court, adult probation, justice courts and municipal courts." And,

WHEREAS, it is more practical and effective for the Presiding Judge of the Mesa Municipal Court to exercise this authority relevant to the construction of the new court facility in Mesa.

IT IS ORDERED that the Presiding Judge of the Mesa Municipal Court shall be delegated this authority as stated above.
