The Court recognizing that permanency is in the best interests of children and directly affects their well being, and the Court further recognizing the need to eliminate all unnecessary delay in the processing of juvenile cases on appeal,

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to Rule 88(D), Az Rules of Juvenile Procedure, automatically appointing appellate counsel for all indigent parties for whom a Notice of Appeal from a final order of the juvenile court has been filed and for whom the appointment of counsel is required by law. All such parties who have not yet filed previously with the Court a Financial Affidavit shall do so within ten (10) business days of the appointment of appellate counsel. All parties have an affirmative obligation to keep the court apprised through their counsel of any change in financial status by filing a current Financial Affidavit. Parties who do not qualify as indigent shall be assessed reasonable attorney's fees.
