Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>K'iche' court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for K'iche' speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable K'iche' language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>K'iche' interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Martin Poz Perez, a California-based interpreter with experience in Superior and Federal Court, be allowed to work as an English<>K'iche' contract court interpreter during the period April 7, 2008 through December 31, 2008.
2. Mr. Poz Perez will be compensated at the rate of \$40.00 per hour for telephonic interpretation with a minimum of a two-hour engagement.
3. Mr. Poz Perez be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Poz Perez abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
