Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Ixil court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Ixil speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Ixil language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English>Ixil interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Mark Willis, a Georgia-based interpreter with experience in Superior and Federal Court, be allowed to work as an English<>Ixil contract court interpreter during the period April 8, 2008 through December 31, 2008.
2. Mr. Willis will be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 per hour for telephonic interpretation.
3. Mr. Willis be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Willis abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
