Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Gio court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Gio speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Gio language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Gio interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Wilfred Smallwood be allowed to work as an English<>Gio contract court interpreter during the period May 14, 2008 through June 1, 2008.
2. Mr. Wilfred Smallwood be compensated according to the terms and conditions of the existing F-2 Contract for court interpreters.
3. Mr. Wilfred Smallwood be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Wilfred Smallwood abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
