ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On May 6, 1998, the judges of Superior Court of Arizona, in and for Maricopa County, adopted a revised Judicial Merit System Resolution and Rules for the Judicial Branch of Arizona in Maricopa County, effective July 1, 1998.

Pursuant to Administrative Order 98-034, the Judicial Merit System Commission was established for the Judicial Branch in the Superior Court of the State of Arizona, in and for the County of Maricopa, effective July 1, 1998.
