Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Gio court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Gio speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Gio language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Gio interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Amos Logan be allowed to work as an English<>Gio contract court interpreter during the period January 27, 2009 – June 30, 2010.
2. Mr. Amos Logan register as a Maricopa County vendor before he is engaged as a contract interpreter.
3. Mr. Amos Logan be compensated at the rates currently offered to other contract interpreters under Court Contract (09005).
4. Mr. Amos Logan be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
5. Mr. Amos Logan abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
