Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Nuer court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Nuer speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Nuer language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Nuer interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Anderia Arok be allowed to work as an English<>Nuer contract court interpreter during the period March 1, 2009 through March 1, 2010.
2. Mr. Anderia Arok be compensated according to the terms and conditions of the existing Court Contract for court interpreters.
3. Mr. Anderia Arok be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Anderia Arok abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
