Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Mixteco Bajo court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Mixteco Bajo speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Mixteco Bajo language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Mixteco Bajo interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Adolfo Flores be allowed to work as an English<>Mixteco Bajo contract court interpreter during the period June 2009 through December 2009.
2. Mr. Adolfo Flores will be compensated at the rate of \$1,200.00 per day plus \$400.00 for travel time. All travel and lodging expenses will be borne by the Court. Mr. Flores will receive a maximum of \$50.00 per diem for incidental expenses; receipts must be submitted along with invoices.
3. Mr. Adolfo Flores will be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Adolfo Flores will abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
