This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 111-22-018 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Appendix A. This contested case involves claims for water rights for irrigation, domestic, and stock watering uses. Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") found no irrigation or domestic use, but it did find a potential water right for stock watering for the land located in section 04 Township 22S Range 18E in Santa Cruz County, Arizona.

Claimants and Landowner

On May 29, 1979, Roy and Margaret Ewing, as owners of Z Triangle Ranch, filed Statement of Claimant 39-1584 for water rights for irrigation, domestic use, and stock and wildlife watering. The Arizona Department of Water Resources matched the Statement of Claimant with Statement of Claim 36-64468. A subsequent filing by Mr. Ewing reported a sale of property to The Nature Conservancy. The WFR lists the Arizona Chapter of the Nature Conservancy as the landowner. A copy of a map from the Santa Cruz County Assessor's Office is attached as Appendix B showing the location of tax parcels 108-37-004, 108-37-003B, 108-51-003B, and 108-52-001. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of the Statement of Claimant to The Nature Conservancy.

Adjudication of Water Right for Stock Watering

In 1994, the Special Master issued a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision established the procedures for adjudicating de minimis water

rights for claims in the San Pedro watershed. As required by the Decision, a proposed water right abstract has been prepared for the *de minimis* water right analyzed by the WFR for review by ADWR. A proposed abstract is attached as Appendix C. In addition, ADWR shall map the location of the stock and wildlife watering use reported in the WFR.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Nature Conservancy* – *SV* and it will address the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-22-018 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website:

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the Watershed File Report who are listed on Appendix D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Appendix D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.

- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.
- 4. <u>Courtesy Email List.</u> The Special Master's office will email courtesy copies of orders and minute entries entered in this case to persons listed on Appendix D. Requests for inclusions on the email list may be sent to Durina Farrall at <u>durina.farrall@jbazmc.maricopa.gov.</u>
- 5. Review and Map. Arizona Department of Water Resources shall review and provide comments on the attached abstract and prepare a map of the area that was the subject of the investigation reported in the WFR showing the location of the stock watering use. The report and map shall be filed by ADWR by May 14, 2021.
- 6. Status Conference. A telephonic status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of the claimed and investigated water rights and determine whether the current landowner intends to pursue a right to water use on the land, and if so, the nature of the water rights claimed. The telephonic status conference shall be held in this case at 3:30 p.m. on May 20, 2021.


