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On February 27, 2019, the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) filed a Meeting Report stating that its staff and counsel had met with counsel for one of the landowners in this case, the trustee of the D. Stadtler 2015 Trust, along with several of the parties who filed objections to Watershed File Report No. 112-17-ABC-001 (WFR). Based on the Meeting

Report, a representative of the Pomerene Domestic Water Improvement District did not attend the meeting scheduled by ADWR.

The WFR lists potential water rights for irrigation and domestic uses in the southeast quarter of section 2 T17S R20E and irrigation uses in the southwest quarter of section 1 and the southeast quarter of section 2 T17S R20E supplied by three wells and a diversion from the San Pedro River into the Pomerene Water Users Association Canal. The Pomerene Water Users Association has terminated. A number of former members have joined the St. David Irrigation District and a portion of the lands serviced has been annexed by the St. David Irrigation District, but the D. Stadtler 2015 Trust, Pomerene Domestic Water Improvement District and the land described in the WFR are not included within those members or lands. Thus, the remaining sources of water for the potential water rights identified in the WFR are three wells. Those wells are located within the subflow zone as mapped by ADWR.

According to the Meeting Report, counsel for the D. Stadtler 2015 Trust informed the parties that Statement of Claimant 39-5659 will be amended to replace the sources of water for the land included in tax parcels 12301007 and 12301001A with wells located outside the subflow zone.

As the Pomerene Domestic Water Improvement District did not appear at the status conference in this matter on November 29, 2018, did not attend the scheduled meeting with ADWR, and has not filed a Statement of Claimant for use of water on land in tax parcel 12301001B, it does not appear that Pomerene Domestic Water Improvement District has an interest in claiming any water rights identified in the WFR.

IT IS ORDERED that by May 1, 2019, the landowners shall file an amended Statement of Claimant for claims for water rights on its land included in the WFR. The landowners shall

designate with respect to sources of water that are wells whether those wells are located within the subflow zone. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a status conference shall be held on May 9, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. in the Superior Court of Arizona, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, 201 West Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2202 to consider the amended Statements of Claimant. The absence of a representative of the Pomerene Domestic Water Improvement District stating its intent to pursue a claim for a water right included in the WFR at the status hearing will result in the removal of the Pomerene Domestic Water Improvement District from this case.
