Status conference set to determine proceedings necessary to address potential water rights for irrigation and small reservoir uses. **NUMBER OF PAGES: 15** DATE OF FILING: October 30, 2018 This contested case involves potential water rights for an irrigation and small reservoir use in the northeast quarter of section 34 T16S R20E identified by the Arizona Department of 

Water Resources in Watershed File Report No. 112-17-BAA-062 (WFR). The WFR listed the

sources of water as one well and a diversion from the San Pedro River into the Pomerene Water Users Association Canal. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. Franklin T. East filed the applicable adjudication filing, which is Statement of Claimant 39-4085. The records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not show that this Statement of Claimant has been assigned to a successor landowner. A copy of the map prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources for the WFR is attached as Attachment B. The purpose of this case is to resolve the five objections to those water rights to the extent that the current landowners intend to pursue them.

### Background

Until October 5, 2018, this case was consolidated and a part of that group of cases known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association*, contested case no. W1-11-1676. In that case, the court scheduled a status conference for June 28, 2017 in part to identify the proper parties in the case. At the status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association was given until October 2, 2017 to provide documentation concerning its continuing authority to act. No landowners appeared at the status conference.

By order dated July 26, 2017, the court directed the landowners to file new or amended statements of claimant if they desired to assert a claim for a right to divert water through the Pomerene Canal for irrigation use. A second status conference was set for October 18, 2017. Copies of the order were sent, among others, to: Brendan Tammetta, Jason Carrol and Terrance and Phyllis Harrold. No Statements of Claimant have been filed by Brendan Tammetta, Jason Carrol or Terrance and Phyllis Harrold.

At the status conference held on October 18, 2017, the newly elected board of the Pomerene Water Users Association appeared along with counsel. The court directed the

Pomerene Water Users Association to file a list by December 29, 2017 that identified those landowners who are members by the Pomerene Water Users Association and whose interests will be represented by the Pomerene Water Users Association in the adjudication of water rights. The court also set a third status conference for September 6, 2018. Copies of the order were sent to the landowners listed above. On December 21, 2017, the Pomerene Water Users Association timely filed a list of 26 landowners that included Brendan Tammetta, Jason Carrol and Terrance and Phyllis Harrold.

On August 31, 2018, Pomerene Water Users Association filed a Notice of Termination. At the third status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association provided a list of its members who joined the St. David Irrigation District and those members who declined to join the St. David Irrigation District. Brendan Tammetta, Jason Carrol and Terrance and Phyllis Harrold were listed as members who declined to join the St. David Irrigation District.

By order dated October 5, 2018, the cases previously consolidated into a single case known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association* were separated into individual cases. As a result, the potential water rights analyzed in the WFR will be considered in this separate case.

#### Landowners

The first step is to identify the current landowners involved in this case. According to information provided by the Cochise County Assessor's Office, the land included in the WFR consists of the following tax parcels which the Cochise County Treasurer's Office lists as owned by the following individuals:

The second step is to determine whether the well listed in the WFR is located in the subflow zone. The third step is to determine whether the Landowners intend to pursue claims for potential water rights described in the WFR, and, if so, to schedule appropriate procedures to adjudicate those claims.

IT IS ORDERED that by December 3, 2018, the Arizona Department of Water Resources shall file a map that shows Well 1 identified in Watershed File Report 112-17-BAA-062 relative to the boundary of the Subflow Zone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a telephonic status conference shall be held on December 19, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. to ascertain whether the Landowners in this case intend to pursue any of the potential water rights set forth in the WFR.

Water Case No. W1-11, 1875 601 West Jackson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003 by December 14, 2018 and shall provide a copy of the statement to each person listed on Attachment D. Failure to participate at the status conference or file a statement of intent may result in the dismissal of any claims associated with the land owned by the Landowner that is described in the WFR.




