Arizona Department of Water Resources investigated the use of water on the property and included its results in Zone 2 Well Report 112-17-DBA-279 ("Report"), which was published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The Report listed

one well as the source of water. The Report lists no Statements of Claimant. A copy of the Report is attached as Attachment A and a copy of the map of the boundaries of Report, which is labelled as "(279)" is attached as Attachment B. The purpose of this case is to resolve the three objections made to the Report and adjudicate water rights that the District may have made on behalf of the landowner

In a Status Report filed by St. David Irrigation District ("District") dated January 13, 2020, the District stated that it has determined that the landowners in this case are members of the District, receive water and will be represented by the District. The District represents that the property involved is tax parcel numbers 121-17-036. The Cochise County Assessor names Miriam Gay Anderson as the owner of the property. 


