PROPOSED WATER RIGHTS

CONTESTED CASE NAME: *In re Hopi I. Jones III*

HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Special Master issues an abstract for a proposed water right for a stockpond analyzed by Watershed File Report No. 113-12-037 and sets a deadline to file suggested corrections.

This case involves *de minimis* claims for water rights analyzed by Watershed File Report 113-12-037 included in the final hydrographic survey report for the San Pedro Watershed ("San Pedro HSR") filed on November 20, 1991. In 1994, the Special Master issued

1 a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases
2 involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended
3 February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision
4 established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water rights for claims in the San Pedro
5 watershed.



7 Once the proposed water right abstracts have been prepared, "the litigants will be
8 provided an opportunity to suggest the correction of mistakes in the proposed abstracts."
9 Decision, p. 47. This proceeding is not a forum in which to relitigate the Decision, which was
10 the subject of years of briefing and has now been affirmed for almost 18 years. Subsequently,
11 these abstracts will be included in a catalog of proposed water rights where they will be subject
12 to very limited set of objections and ultimately in a final decree.

14 As required by the Decision, a proposed water right abstract has been prepared for the *de*
15 *minimis* water right analyzed by Watershed File Report 113-12-037, which is attached as
16 Appendix A along with a map prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources.

18 **IT IS ORDERED** that any suggested corrections to the proposed abstract shall be filed
19 on or before **October 15, 2020**.




