According to the Report, proposed abstracts for water rights analyzed in Watershed File

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Report 113-12-BD-002 (the "WFR") were prepared by counsel for Pima Counsel and circulated among the parties who filed objections to the WFR. The proposed abstracts appear to be acceptable to BHP Copper, Inc. and ASARCO, LLC for purposes of settling their objections. As to the remaining objectors, the Report states that certain water right characteristics appear to be resolved while other characteristics are either under study or the subject of objections by the parties. The United States and the Gila Indian Community had only recently received the proposed abstracts at the time of the filing of the Report so their position with respect to the abstracts is unknown.

Counsel for the Yavapai-Apache Nation shall consult with each of the parties and prepare a Second Joint Settlement Report approved by all objectors that includes the most recent abstracts proposed by Pima County and lists with specificity those characteristics in the proposed abstracts to which objections currently exist.

Watershed File Reports 111-19-001, 113-11-003 and 113-12-001

This case also involves *de minimis* claims for water rights analyzed by Watershed File Reports Nos. 111-19-001, 113-11-003 and 113-12-001included in the final hydrographic survey report for the San Pedro Watershed ("San Pedro HSR") filed on November 20, 1991. In 1994, the Special Master issued a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water rights for claims in the San Pedro watershed.

Once the proposed water right abstracts have been prepared, "the litigants will be provided an opportunity to suggest the correction of mistakes in the proposed abstracts." Decision, p. 47. This proceeding is not a forum in which to relitigate the Decision, which

the subject of years of briefing and has now been affirmed for more than 14 years. Subsequently, these abstracts will be included in a catalog of proposed water rights where they will be subject to very limited set of objections and ultimately in a final decree.

As required by the Decision, six proposed water right abstracts have been prepared for the *de minimis* water rights analyzed by Watershed File Reports Nos. 111-19-001, 113-11-003 and 113-12-001 which are attached as Appendix A. The parties shall be permitted 60 days to file suggested corrections to the proposed abstracts. No abstract was prepared for PWR 113-12-001-SW001 because uncertainty exists as to the correct legal description for the place of use. *See Report re Land Ownership in WFR 113-12-001*, filed by the Arizona State Land Department on April 23, 2018.¹

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. A Joint Settlement Report shall be filed by November 9, 2018.
- 2. Any suggested corrections to the proposed abstracts shall be filed on or before December 10, 2018.
- 3. Arizona Department of Water Resources shall review PWR no. 113-12-001-SW001 and submit a report and map of use defining the place of use by November 9, 2018.
