DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Telephonic Status Conference shall be held on September

DATE OF FILING: July 13, 2020

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This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of

those persons who filed statements of claimant to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

This contested case shall determine the claims for water rights listed in and resolve the objections to Watershed File Report 113-12-DD-001 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic and irrigation uses for the land described in the WFR located in sections 31 and 32 Township 13S Range 20E. The identified sources of water for the claimed uses is one well located in section 32 T13S R20E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that Well 01, which is the source of water for irrigation use, is located within the subflow zone. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B on which the land investigated is labelled with "(01)". A copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified two Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water rights: 39-3890 and 39-14406. Marie Kelly filed SOC 39-3890. David and Fay Gard subsequently filed a form of assignment of SOC 39-3890 to which they attached a statement that they had purchased the property from the personal representative of the Estate of Marie Kelly. The representative of the estate of Marie Kelly did not sign the form of assignment. David and Fay Gard also filed SOC 39-14406. The Arizona Department of Water Resources listed David and Fay Gard as the owners of the property described in the WFR. The public records of Cochise County Assessor's Office identify Joel and Donna Quisenberry as the owners of tax parcel 209-53-001. The public records maintained by ADWR do not include assignments of the SOCs from David and Fay Gard.

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IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re In re David and Fay Gard and it will address Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding Watershed File Report 113-12-DD-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, all persons who 2. filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

Telephonic Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to 5. address the adjudication of this case, determine whether the Claimants or current landowners intend to pursue water rights for the property. If so, then a discussion will be held to determine whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. Telephonic Status Conference shall be held on September 10, 2020 at 3:00 p.m.




