and ASARCO LLC.¹ A reference is also made to the need to take additional action due to a transfer of land to the United States Bureau of Reclamation, although no description is given of the land involved. ASARCO LLC further seeks additional time to gather factual information to amend its claims for water rights and to discuss possible settlement with those persons and entities that have filed objections to the potential water rights described in the Watershed File Reports. While it is important that the water rights are properly titled in the names of the correct legal entities, the process of identifying the remaining characteristics of water rights should continue while the formal title transfers and assignments are completed among the entities that appear to be related. To avoid unnecessarily delaying the settlement process or, where necessary, the identification of relevant issues that must be resolved ASARCO, LLC shall file a report explaining its preliminary objections to the potential water rights described in Watershed File Report 114-01-CCD-001, 114-04-BDA-001 and 114-04-BDD-002 based on its extensive field and record research undertaken since July 25, 2018.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED granting an extension of the deadline to file amended statements of claimant until April 8, 2019 and otherwise denying ASARCO LLC's motion to vacate the status conference set for February 8, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ASARCO LLC shall file with the court by January 31, 2019, a report describing its preliminary objections to the potential water rights at issue in this case.
