This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 114-04-BAB-002 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for irrigation for the land described in the WFR located in section 07 Township 6S Range 16E, which is Arizona State Trust land. The WFR identified the source of water for the claimed use as water from a well located in SWNWSE section 06 T6S R16E and a well in NWNWSW

section 08 T6S R16E. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B and a copy of the current State Land Department map is attached as Attachment C.

Claimants and Landowners

The WFR identified two potential irrigation rights, IR006 and IR007, that protrude onto the land included in WFR 114-04-BAB-002 from adjoining parcels. The land labelled as IR006 protrudes onto the northern part of the property from WFR 114-04-BAB-007, which is the subject of contested case no. W1-11-3107, and IR007 protrudes onto the western part of the property from WFR 114-04-BAB-001, which is the subject of contested case no. W1-11-3103.

The WFR identified three Statements of Claimant (SOC), 39-2221, 39-2225, and 39-6730. Paul L. Sale Investment Co. filed SOCs 39-2221 and 39-2225 on December 17, 1979. On April 30, 1997, Paul L. Sale Investment Co. assigned SOCs 39-2221 and 39-2225 to The Nature Conservancy. On May 31, 2017, The Nature Conservancy assigned SOCs 39-2221 and 39-2225 to Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District.

Statement of Claimant 39-6730 filed by the Arizona State Land Department claimed a right to water for irrigation use in the southeast quarter of section 07 T6S R16E. The Arizona State Land Department has stated that it does not intend to pursue claims associated with SOC 39-6730 and that SOC was dismissed during the status conference for *In re Paul L. Sale Investment Co.* contested case no. W1-11-3107 on June 18, 2019.

IT IS ORDERED;

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Salt River Project* – *River Preserve II* and it will address claims for water rights included in watershed file report

114-04-BAB-002 and objections that were filed to that WFR published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file report who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

5. Status Report and Conference. Salt River Project shall file a status report by October 18, 2019, which shall identify the applicable adjudication filings and pre-filings for claims for water use. It shall also set forth the positions of Salt River Project and the Arizona State Land Department regarding the ownership of the claimed water rights. An initial status conference shall be held on November 1, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in the Superior Court of Arizona, 201 West Jefferson Street, Courtroom 301, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2202




