At issue in this consolidated contested case are claims for water rights that are the subject of Watershed File Reports 114-04-BAB-007 and 114-01-CCD-012. The parties have been negotiating proposed abstracts for water rights to the property since October 2019. In its Third Status Report filed March 17, 2020, Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and Salt River Valley Water Users' Association ("SRP") stated that it could not represent

1 that a settlement could be reached with all objectors in the next thirty to ninety days and requested
2 that a Scheduling Conference be set. Accordingly,

3 **IT IS ORDERED** that each party shall file a Disclosure Statement that complies with
4 Ariz. R. Civ. P. 26.1 by **May 4, 2020**. It is expected that each Disclosure Statement shall be a
5 substantive, good faith effort to comply with Rule 26.1.

6 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** setting a telephonic Scheduling Conference on **May 12,**
7 **2020 at 1:30 p.m.**
