Background

On March 3, 1989, Mr. and Mrs. Farrier filed a Statement of Claimant with the Arizona Department of Water Resources. They claimed a right to water to irrigate ten acres of land. Mr. and Mrs. Farrier represented that a Well, Well Registration No. 55-801979, provided the source of water used for irrigation. The Arizona Department of Water Resources investigated the claim and filed a report stating that no irrigation use had been found at the claimed location. A copy of the report is attached to the Order issued in this case on November 20, 2019. Objections to the report were subsequently filed.

Current Actions

On November 20, 2019, this case was initiated to consider the claim for a water right for irrigation made by Mr. and Mrs. Farrier. The first step in the process was to determine whether the Well was included in an area known as the "subflow zone". Wells located in the subflow zone are presumed to be pumping surface water. On December 6, 2019, the Arizona Department of Water Resources filed a map showing the location of the Well. Based on the map, the Well is located within the subflow zone.

Status Hearing

The next step in this proceeding is to set a status hearing to determine whether Mr. and Mrs. Farrier intend to pursue a claim for a water right for irrigation use.

IT IS ORDERED setting a Status Conference to determine whether Mr. and Mrs. Farrier intend to pursue a claim for a water right for irrigation use and, if so, determine the appropriate procedures to complete the process of resolving objections and adjudicating the
