Gegax. 27

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This contested case is one of the many cases that are included in the General Stream Adjudication. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of those persons who use water from the San Pedro watershed in addition to the watersheds for the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz. Other cases in the General Stream Adjudication have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. This case is initiated to determine water rights to water in the San Pedro watershed.

**Claims for Water Rights** 

This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 114-04-BAC-003 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic and irrigation use on land located in sections 16 and 17 Township 6S Range 16E. The identified source of water for the claimed uses is a well located in section 17 T6S R16E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that the well is located in the subflow zone. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B on which the land in question is labelled as "(003)". A copy of the map prepared by the Pinal County Assessor showing tax parcel 300-27-008 is attached as Attachment C.

## Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified one Statement of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-10851. Edward Gegax filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation use. Mr. and Mrs. Gegax filed a Uniform Questionnaire on September 11, 1989, in which the described water uses included domestic and irrigation use.

The WFR lists Edward H. and Bettie M. Gegax as the owners of the property described in the WFR. According to the records of the Pinal County Records, Edward H. and Bettie M. Gegax own the property included in the WFR.

#### IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Edward H. and Bettie M. Gegax* and it will determine water rights asserted in the SOC and objections that were filed to WFR 114-04-BAC-003 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the listed WFRs who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.
  - 3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>
    - A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
    - B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
    - C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

4. <u>Courtesy Email List.</u>

5. Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Edward H. and Bettie M. Gegax intend to pursue their claim for a water right and, if so, whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Scheduling Conference. The Status Conference shall be held on January 7, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. before:




