Discussion is held regarding the Statement of Claimant filed by Mr. Hernandez. The Court notes that it was not assigned to Mr. Avechucu.

Mr. Avechuco states his interest in pursuing the claim for water rights. He agrees to a meeting with the objectors and Arizona Department of Water Resources.

There being no objection from the other parties,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED directing Ms. Parks to schedule a meeting with ADWR, the objectors and Mr. and Mrs. Avechuco by **March 31, 2020**.
