NUMBER OF PAGES: 3 DATE OF FILING: March 17, 2020 On March 3, 2020, Arizona Department of Water Resources filed a Report and map of the land investigated in Watershed File Report 114-04-BAC-009. As mapped, all of the land involved 

in this case is located in section 16 and 17 Township 6S R16E. The ownership of the relevant land in sections 16 and 17 according to the Pima Country Recorder is as follows:

Arizona Department of Water Resources prepared the map attached to its Report to answer the question whether the property identified by the Pima County Assessor as owned by Sandra and James Goad, tax parcel 300-55-009, was included in the investigative report. It determined that the Goad property was included in Watershed File Report 114-04-BAC-009. Specifically, it reported that the Goad land consists of 0.94 acres and evidenced prior irrigation usage that had been discontinued. It also reported that Well 55-530492 registered by Sandra and James Goad is located in the subflow zone. According to the Well Driller Report, Well 55-530492 was drilled in 1991. Sandra and James Goad have not filed a Statement of Claimant for a right to use water on tax parcel 300-55-009.

On June 19, 1992, Augustine and Martha Avechuco filed Statement of Claimant 39-14746 claiming water for domestic and irrigation uses. Well 55-806362 is the well identified in the Watershed File Report 114-04-BAC-009 as the source of water for the claimed domestic and irrigation uses. In its report, ADWR confirmed that Well 55-806362 is also located in the subflow zone.

IT IS ORDERED that ADWR shall schedule a meeting between Augustine and Martha Avechuco and the objectors to be held no later than May 15, 2020. If Sandra and James Goad file a Statement of Claimant for a right to a water, they shall be notified of and invited to participate in the meeting if the claimed priority date in the Statement of Claimant is prior to 1991. If Sandra and James Goad do not file a Statement of Claimant or if they file a Statement of Claimant with a priority date of 1991 or later, then no further action shall be taken in this case with respect to rights for water use on tax parcel 300-55-009.
