stipulation and submitted proposed abstracts for water rights that the Court approved by Orders dated July 31, 2019. Due to the parties' agreement and the stipulated abstracts, the Scheduling Conference conditionally set for August 15, 2019 will not occur.

Additional information is, however, required from Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and Salt River Valley Water Users' Association (SRP) to fully resolve the water rights investigated by the watershed file reports. In each case, an abstract was not submitted for a potential irrigation right and with respect to watershed file report 114-04-BDD-029, an abstract was not submitted for a domestic use, but an abstract was submitted for a stock watering use as shown below:
