This contested case was initiated to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 114-04-BDD-030 ("WFR") prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources and published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR listed Statement of Claimant 39-4846 (SOC) as the applicable claim to appropriable water for use on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR. It also listed ASARCO, Inc. as the landowner.

Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District ("SRP" or "Salt River Project") is the current claimant pursuant to the SOC. The records of the Pinal County Assessor list Arizona Game and Fish Commission as the current owner of the property described in the WFR.

On January 24, 2020, SRP and Arizona Game and Fish Commission filed a Joint Report in which SRP stated that it does not intend to claim rights to water for use on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR. Arizona Game and Fish Commission stated that it also does not intent to claim rights to water for use on the land and will not request an assignment of the SOC.

Pursuant to the Order dated December 24, 2020, ASARCO, Inc. was given until February 4, 2020, to file an amended objection if it intended to assert ownership of the relevant land. No amended objection has been received by the Court. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that this contested case is dismissed and no rights to water for use on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR shall be proposed to be included in the final decree.
