The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic and irrigation associated with an irrigation use on land located in section 4 Township 7S Range 16E. The identified source of water for the claimed uses is a well located in section 4 Township 7S Range 16E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that the well is located in the subflow zone.

A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B on which the land in question is labelled as "(30)". A copy of the map prepared by the Pinal County Assessor showing tax parcel 300-31-004 is attached as Attachment C.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified one Statement of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-4846. Edwin Ash filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation and stock watering uses. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources include an assignment of SOC 39-4846 to Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District ("SRP" or "Salt River Project"). Statement of Claimant 39-4846 was also included in Watershed File Report 114-04-BDD-029 that was the subject of Contested Case No. W1-11-3201, which was consolidated with Contested Case No. W1-11-3194.

The WFR lists ASARCO as the owner of the property described in the WFR, but ASARCO in its objection filed May 11, 1992 states that "ASARCO is not the land owner in this WFR." Objection at 3. The records of the Pinal County Assessor list Arizona Game and Fish Commission as the current owner of the property described in the WFR.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re ASARCO-SRP* and it will determine water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 114-04-BDD-030 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

4. <u>Courtesy Email List.</u>

The Special Master's office will email courtesy copies of orders and minute entries entered in this case to persons listed on Attachment D. Requests for inclusions on the email list should be sent to Barbara Brown at brownb099@superiorcourt.maricopa.gov.

- 5. <u>Joint Report.</u> Arizona Game and Fish Commission and SRP shall file a joint report by February 4, 2020, which shall state whether:
 - a. Arizona Game and Fish intends to request an assignment of SOC 39-4846
 from SRP;
 - b. Arizona Game and Fish intends to claim a right to water for use on the land included in the boundaries of the land mapped by ADWR for Watershed File Report 114-04-BDD-030 as shown on Attachment B. If so, Arizona Game and Fish Commission shall identify the source of water; and
 - Salt River Project intends to assert a claim for a water right pursuant to SOC 39-4846.

The joint report shall also include the recommendations of Arizona Game and Fish Commission and SRP about the next action to be taken in this case.

6. <u>ASARCO Objection.</u> If ASARCO intends to modify its Objection to claim ownership to the land included in the boundaries of the land mapped by ADWR for Watershed File Report 114-04-BDD-030, it shall file an amended Objection by February 4, 2020.




