the Pinal County Assessor has identified as tax parcels 302-02-007, 306-03-001, 306-08-002,

and 306-09-002, owned by Harriett F. Hedrick and Beverly Meade Miller.

This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of those persons who use water from the San Pedro watershed in addition to the watersheds for the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz. Other cases in the General Stream Adjudication have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. This case is initiated to determine water rights to water in the San Pedro watershed.

Claims for Water Rights

This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 114-04-DCA-001 ("WFR") prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources and published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991).

The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic and irrigation use on land located in section 12 Township 8S Range 16E and sections 1, 6, 7, and 12 Township 8S Range 17E. According to maps maintained by the Arizona State Land Department, land located in NE section 12 T8S R17E and in SE section 1 T8S R17E is Arizona State Trust Land. The maps prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources for the WFR do not include land in these two sections. Accordingly, at this point this case will proceed with respect to claimed water rights for water on land in Sections 1 and 12 T8S R16E and Sections 6 and 7 T8S R17E as mapped by Arizona Department of Water Resources.

The identified source of water for the claimed uses is a well located in NWNWNW section 7 T8S R17E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that the well is located in the subflow zone.

A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B on which land in sections 1 and 12, T8S R16E and in sections 6 and 7 in T8S R17E are labelled as "(1)" or "(DCA-1)". A copy of the map prepared by the

Pinal County Assessor showing tax parcels 302-02-007, 306-03-001, 306-08-002, and 306-09-002 is attached as Attachment C.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified one Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-4235. Clarence R. Miller filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation, stock watering, and domestic uses. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not include an assignment of the SOC filed by Clarence R. Miller or the personal representative of his estate to the current landowners.

The WFR identified Clarence R. Miller as the owner of the property. On June 28, 2006, Harriett F. Hedrick recorded Letters of Appointment which named her as the personal representative of the Estate of Clarence Rowden Miller with the Pinal County Recorder's Office. See Fee Number 2006-091742. On July 7, 2006, a Deed of Distribution was recorded that transferred the property in undivided shares to Ralph Mark Miller, Harriett Hedrick, and Sonja Murphey. See Fee No. 2006-096618. In 2012, Sonja Murphey transferred an undivided one-third interest in the property to Harriett Hedrick, and Katherine Elizabeth Miller, as personal representative of the Estate of Ralph Mark Miller, conveyed a one-third interest in the property to Beverly Meade Miller. See Fee Nos. 2012-024472 and 2012-034563. The records of the Pinal County Assessor list as the owners of the property described in the WFR as Harriett Hedrick and Beverly Meade Miller.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Clarence R. Miller* and it will determine water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 114-04-DCA-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website:

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Estate of the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

4. Courtesy Email List.

The Special Master's office will email courtesy copies of orders and minute entries entered in this case to persons listed on Attachment D. Requests for inclusions on the email list should be sent to Barbara Brown at brownb099@superiorcourt.maricopa.gov.

5. Status Conference.

- A. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Statement of Claimant filed by Clarence R. Miller has been assigned to the current landowners and whether the current landowners intend to pursue the claims for water rights originally filed by Mr. Miller.
- B. At the initial status conference, Arizona Department of Water Resources will clarify whether Watershed File Report 114-04-DCA-001 includes an investigation of and potential water rights for land in Sections 1 and 12, T8S R17E.
- C. If water rights will be pursued with respect to the land shown on the map attached as Attachment B in Sections 1 and 12 T8S R16E and Sections 6 and 7 T8S R17E, then a discussion will occur at the initial status conference about whether objections to the WFR can be settled and the amount of time that the parties will require to discuss the resolution of the objections.






