This is a proceeding to adjudicate the validity of the claims made by Russell L. Richardson and Sheila C. Richardson for water for domestic and irrigation uses. The property at issue is located in two sections: section 34 T6S R17E and section 03 T7S R17E. Proposed abstracts for domestic and irrigation uses in section 34 T6S R17E have been issued. The legal basis for the claim for the water rights was provided by the actions and documents filed by

William Row that concerned section 34 T6S R17E. Mr. Row's actions and documents do not support the remaining claim in this case for irrigation use on 6400 square feet in section 03 T7S R17E. Thus, the specific issue that must be decided is the legal basis for the right to use water on 0.15 acres in section 3 T7S R17E.

On September 18, 2019, counsel for the Apache Tribe filed historical documents concerning historical water use on section 3 T7S R17E. The public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources include the documents filed in this case and a map purporting to show historical use and diversions of water use in section 3 T7S R17E. A copy of the map is attached as Attachment A.

This case has now been pending for two years and the remaining claim must be resolved. If Mr. and Mrs. Richardson intend to pursue their remaining claim, they should consider collecting historical information about the homesteading of the land they now own in section 3 T7S R17E. At the status conference, depending on the position taken, the court will either dismiss the remaining claim in this case, determine if additional time to allow the parties to resolve objections is warranted, or set the case for hearing where the parties will be given the

opportunity to present witnesses and evidence to support their respective claims and objections. Failure to appear at the status conference may result in the dismissal of the remaining claim.
