This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 115-04-ADC-002 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for irrigation for the land described in the WFR located in section 04 Township 7S Range 17E. The identified sources of water for the claimed uses are surface water from Aravaipa Creek and two wells. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the

map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B and a copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified two Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-11526 and 39-11527. William C. Farney filed SOC 39-11526 claiming a domestic use and SOC 39-11527 claiming an irrigation use for a garden and an orchard. The WFR lists William C. and Rafaela Farney as the owner of the property described in 115-04-ADC-002.

By Warranty Deed filed on December 9, 1998, William C. and Rafaela Farney conveyed tax parcel 300-42-062B to Carol Steele. On September 2, 2016, William and Rafaela Farney assigned SOC 39-11526 and SOC 39-11527 to Carol Steele. By a Special Warranty Deed filed October 14, 2016, Carol Steele conveyed land to Aravaipa Farm, LLC and an assignment filed on December 5, 2016 assigned SOC 39-11526 and SOC 39-11527 to Aravaipa Farm, LLC. The public records of Pinal County Assessor's Office show Aravaipa Farm as the owner of tax parcels 300-42-0120 and 300-42-002Z. Larry T. and Susan C. Steele own tax parcels 300-42-002W and 300-42-002X. The public records maintained by ADWR do not show that Larry T. and Susan C. Steele have filed a SOC. The Nature Conservancy owns 300-42-001G, but that land has already been mapped and is the subject of proposed abstract 115-04-011-WL001, a copy of which is attached as Attachment E.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Aravaipa Farm*, *LLC* and it will address Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding the watershed file report 115-04-ADC-002 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.






