This Order initiates a contested case to resolve objections to Watershed File Report 115-04-ADC-003 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. The WFR identifies potential water rights for a domestic use and an irrigation use associated with domestic use for the land described in the WFR located in the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of

section 04 Township 7S Range 17E. A copy of the map prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources for the land included in the WFR is attached as Attachment B and the land is marked with a (3). The identified source of water for the claimed uses is a well.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified Dorothy Ouillette as the landowner of the property included in the WFR. On August 25, 2005, Ms. Ouillette filed statement of Claimant 39-15917 to claim 1.2 acre feet of water for domestic and irrigation use. She listed the means of diversion as a well under Well Registration No. 55-900852.

Following the issuance of the WFR, Dorothy Ouillette transferred land in NWSE section 04 T7S R17E, tax parcel no. 300-42-003A to herself as trustee of the Dorothy M. Ouillette Revocable Living Trust, dated November 1, 2004. *See* Quitclaim Deed, filed December 3, 2004 with the Pinal County Recorder, fee number 2004-099166. A copy of the parcel map accessed from the public records of the Pinal County Assessor is attached as Attachment C. On June 14, 2011, a death certificate for Dorothy M. Ouillette was filed with the Pinal County Recorder. On June 14, 2011, Michael W. Ouillette and Marie A. Ouillette, successor trustees of The Dorothy M. Ouillette Revocable Living Trust, quitclaimed the land to themselves as trustees of The Ouillette Family Real Property Trust. See Quitclaim Deed recorded with the Pinal County Recorder at fee number 2011-049575.

On March 22, 2019, Michael W. Ouillette and Marie A. Ouillette as Trustees of the Ouillette Family Real Property Trust transferred land NWSE section 04 T7S R17E located north and west of the Aravaipa River but not north and west of Aravaipa Road to Julia Pemberton. *See* Warranty Deed recorded with the Pinal County Recorder at fee number 2019-020112. The public records of ADWR do not contain an assignment of the statement of claimant.

Status Conference

An initial status conference shall be held in this case to determine if the current landowner intends to assert claims for the potential water rights included in the WFR. Failure to participate at the status conference with the Arizona Department of Water Resources may result in a dismissal of the filed statement of claimant and no further adjudication of the potential water rights listed in the WFR.

IT IS ORDERED that ADWR shall prepare a map of the well relative to the boundaries of the subflow zone and file it with the court by July 10, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Ouillette* and it will address objections that were filed to the watershed file report 115-04-ADC-003 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimant's successors in interest, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file report who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.




