


FIGURE 1. Map of boundaries of WFR 115-05-055 in sections 21, 28 and 27 T7S R20E.

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This contested case concerns only those claims for rights to water for uses other than

irrigation and domestic purposes included within the boundaries of Watershed File Report 115-05-055 (the "WFR") and the objections to the WFR.¹ A map of the land in question is shown in *figure 1* and labelled as "(55)."

There are potentially three Statements of Claimant that assert rights to water for use on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR.

1. Statement of Claimant 39-6478

On February 4, 2020, the trustees of the Magoffin Family Trust filed an amendment to Statement of Claimant 39-6478. The original Statement of Claimant 39-6478 asserted a right to two acre feet of water for domestic purposes from a well in the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter (NENW) of section 27 Township 7 South, Range 20E. It did not identify a place of use. The amended Statement of Claimant claims three acre feet of water, did not

identify the purpose of the use, and identified the place of use as Graham County tax parcel 110-45-021C, a 1,151.34-acre parcel that includes the land investigated by the WFR. The amended Statement of Claimant also listed Graham County tax parcel 110-45-036 as an additional place of use. Graham County tax parcel 110-45-036 is a 32-acre parcel that is not included in the land within the mapped boundaries of the WFR.

2. Statement of Claimant 39-12022

On January 9, 2020, Matthew O. and Anna M. Magoffin and the Arizona State Land Department filed a Joint Ownership of Water Rights Report ("Report"). In the Report, the Arizona State Land Department stated that the stockpond identified in the WFR is located in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NWSWNW) of Section 28, Township 7 South, Range 20 East and is based on surface water filing no. 33-087761.

On February 13, 2020, the trustees of the Magoffin Family Trust filed an amendment to Statement of Claimant 39-12022 claiming a right to water for a stockpond located in the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter (SENW) of Section 28, Township 7 South, Range 20 East. They claimed the Permit to Appropriate Public Water of the State of Arizona 33-087761 as the legal basis of their water right. This permit identified Squaw Creek, a tributary of Aravaipa Creek, as the source of water for 350,400 gallons of water per year for stock watering and 4.3 acre-feet of water to be stored in a reservoir in the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NWNW) of Section 28, Township 7 South, Range 20 East with a priority date of February 10, 1983.

The WFR lists a 5.5-acre stock pond in the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter (NWSENW) of Section 28, Township 7 South, Range 20 East with an estimated volume of 29.9 acre-feet and lists no applicable pre-filing. The map of WFR shows a

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stock pond in approximately the middle of the northwest quarter of Section 28, which is more consistent with the legal description provided by the Arizona State Land Department.

3. Statement of Claimant 39-15850

On January 21, 2020, the trustees of the Magoffin Family Trust filed an assignment of Statement of Claimant 39-15850 that included a map highlighting tax parcels 110-45-021C and 110-45-036. The original Statement of Claimant claimed water for domestic and stock watering use in the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter (NESW) quarter of Section 27 Township 7 South, Range 20 East with no stated priority date. The Statement of Claimant lists a well, well registration no. 55-203485, as the source of the water. According to the public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources, this well was not drilled until 2004. The Statement of Claimant was filed in 2005. The installation of the well and the claimed use occurred after the Arizona Department of Water Resources issued the San Pedro Hydrographic Survey Report in 1991. Accordingly, no further action will be taken with respect to this Statement of Claimant in this contested case because it has not been the subject of a report by ADWR that was distributed to other water users as required by Arizona law.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Amendment to Statement of Claimant. The trustees of the Magoffin Family Trust shall file an amendment to Statement of Claimant 39-6478 by June 22, 2020 that identifies the purpose of the claimed three acre feet of water. The amended Statement of Claimant shall also identify the place of use with sufficient particularity so that a determination can be made whether a claim is being made for the use of water on land included within the boundaries of the WFR.

2. <u>ADWR Report</u>. The Arizona Department of Water Resources shall file a report by June 22, 2020 that identifies the location of the stock pond included in the WFR and shall provide its analysis of the size and estimated volume of the stock pond.
