
ORDER TO FILE STIPULATED
PROPOSED FORM OF ABSTRACT

CONTESTED CASE NAME: *In re Alex Pacheco and Christine Salazar Pacheco*
HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report
DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The San Carlos Apache Tribe shall file by May 29, 2020, a fully executed stipulation, withdrawal of objections and request that the Special Master approve proposed water right abstracts.

At the status conference held on February 20, 2020, the parties discussed the proposed abstracts prepared and distributed by Alex Pacheco. The parties requested several changes to be made to the proposed abstracts including the preparation of a map with additional information. See Minute Entry filed February 26, 2020. The Arizona Department of Water Resources

1 (ADWR) was requested to prepare a map for the proposed abstracts that included the longitude
2 and latitude coordinates for the well. Five days later ADWR filed the requested map. On April
3 16, 2020, the Yavapai-Apache Nation withdrew all of its objections to the report filed by ADWR
4 in this case.

5 IT IS ORDERED that the San Carlos Apache Tribe shall file a fully executed stipulation,
6 withdrawal of objections by the remaining Objectors and request that the Special Master approve
7 proposed water right abstracts by **May 29, 2020** or file a status report if the parties are not in
8 agreement with respect to the proposed abstracts.
