

This contested case was initiated on July 3, 2019. To date a status conference has been held and the Arizona Department of Water Resources has facilitated two meetings among the parties and filed reports. A third meeting has been set for May 12, 2020 if the parties are not able to reach agreement on objections prior to that date. By that date this case will have been pending for more than 10 months. Accordingly,

1 IT IS ORDERED that the parties shall either file stipulated abstracts for water rights to  
2 be claimed by **May 19, 2020** or attend a Scheduling Conference in the Superior Court of Arizona,  
3 201 West Jefferson Street, Courtroom 301, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2202. During the Scheduling  
4 Conference, dates shall be set for filing disclosure statements, discovery deadlines, motion  
5 deadlines, and a date shall be set for trial on the water rights and uses that are the subject of  
6 Watershed File Report 115-05-ADC-001.
