26	On November 27, 2019, the Arizona State Land Department and counsel for	
27	Anthony Lunt ("Claimant") filed a Joint Status Report and Request for Extension of Time

("Motion"). In the Motion, the parties represented that the Arizona State Land Department has no claims that are the subject of Watershed File Report 115-10-BBC-001 ("WFR") and filed no objections to the WFR. In addition, Claimant requested an additional extension of time until January 10, 2020 to file a form of abstract and map or abandon the claim asserted in Statement of Claimant 39-4205.

This case was initiated on April 29, 2019 to consider two Statements of Claimant and objections to the WFR. On May 17, 2019, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") filed a map that showed the boundaries of the area included in the A copy of the map is attached as Attachment A. The Claimant was directed to WFR. mark the boundaries of the irrigated land on the map provided by ADWR, and a status conference was set to discuss the action necessary to resolve the objections to the WFR. Order dated April 29, 2019. Claimant did not prepare the map or attend the status conference. Minute Entry dated July 23, 2019. Thereafter, Claimant was given until August 30, 2019 to file stipulated abstracts or file a status report. A timely status report was filed by the Arizona State Land Department reporting Claimant's decision to retain counsel. As a result, an extension was granted until October 4, 2019 to file stipulated abstracts or submit a status report. In the status report timely filed by Claimant, the representation was made that Claimant was in Europe and effectively another extension was requested until November 18, 2019 to file stipulated abstracts.

In the Motion, Claimant requests a fourth extension due to his travel plans and the holidays to file a stipulated form of abstract and map or abandon the irrigation claim by

January 10, 2020. This case has been in process for seven months and three extensions have already been granted to permit Claimant to resolve objections filed in this case. While Claimant may continue to pursue the resolution of objections, no further delay will be permitted in the scheduling of this case to go to hearing.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion is denied and a Scheduling Conference will be held on December 17, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. in Superior Court, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, Phoenix, Arizona 85003 to address discovery, and set dates for motions, a Readiness Conference and trial.
