Bridgewater, has represented in the negotiations in the remainder of the water adjudication that he represents the Indian Resources Section of the U.S. Department of Justice and is dealing only with water rights held in trust by the U.S. for the Navajo Nation. But, in the Motion to Intervene, he also referred to claims of the National Park Service, which has previously been represented in this adjudication by separate counsel, Andrew F. Walch, of the ENRD Division of the Department of Justice. Due to the potential for confusion and conflicts of interest because of the multiplicity of the United States' interests in this matter, ATC requests that Mr. Bridgewater more specifically identify the party or parties on whose behalf he has filed the Motion to Intervene.

WHEREFORE, Intervenor Atkinson Trading Company, Inc., respectfully requests further clarification of the role of the United States in this matter, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems just and appropriate in the circumstances.
