DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Clerk of Apache County is directed to initiate Civil 6417-33-100. Deadline for Arizona Department of Water Resources to file Subflow Zone Report is **September 4, 2026**. Objections to the Subflow Zone Report are due **March 3, 2027**.

This Order initiates the case that will delineate the subflow zone in the Silver Creek Subwatershed. On November 7, 2022, Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") filed a Status Report in case CV6417-33-6781 *In re Lakeside Irrigation Company*, a copy of

which is attached as Attachment A. The Status Report contained two proposals to coordinate the preparation of Subflow Reports for the Lower Little Colorado River subwatershed and the Silver Creek subwatershed. It also contained a description of the watercourses within the watershed that will be the subject of a subflow zone analysis. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that ADWR shall file its report and maps ("Report") delineating the subflow zone for the Silver Creek subwatershed by September 4, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon filing the Report with the Court, ADWR shall send a notice to all persons listed on the Court-approved mailing list for CV 6417, Claimants in the Silver Creek subwatershed, and to "Nonclaimant water users," meaning those persons who ADWR has identified as currently using water within the Silver Creek subwatershed informing them of the availability of its Report and of a Claimant's right to file written objections to the Report. The notice shall state where the Report will be available for inspection or purchase, the deadline and procedure for submitting objections to the Report, and the procedures for obtaining additional information. In addition, ADWR shall post a copy of its Report on its website so that it is available to the general public.

Any Claimant may file objections to the Report by March 3, 2027. Objections shall be filed with the Apache County Superior Court, located at 70 West 3rd South, Saint Johns, Arizona 85936. The mailing address for Apache County Superior Court is P. O. Box 365, St. Johns, AZ 85936.

On October 6, 2022, the Court issued a Minute Entry Order (Order) requesting that ADWR file a report containing information about the scope and time requirements for a subflow zone delineation technical report for the Silver Creek watershed. Pursuant to the Order, ADWR hereby provides its status report.

I. Summary on Scope of Work

ADWR contracted with the Arizona Geological Survey (AZGS) on April 18, 2022, to provide geologic mapping for both the Lower Little Colorado River (LLCR) subwatershed and the Silver Creek subwatershed, as an extension and modification of an existing contract. Mapping for both subwatersheds will begin after completion of geologic mapping in the Verde River watershed. The contract currently requires deliverables for both subwatersheds by December 31, 2023.

Delineating the subflow zone in the Silver Creek subwatershed will progress in three general phases. In phase one, the AZGS will conduct geologic mapping in the Silver Creek subwatershed. In phase two, ADWR will begin assessing floodplain movement in historical imagery and mapping the floodplain using available imagery. Upon receipt of the mapping report and data from AZGS, ADWR will begin phase three, creating the floodplain Holocene alluvium boundaries and delineating its proposed subflow zone in accordance with the criteria described in applicable court orders.

ADWR has preliminarily identified twenty watercourses in the Silver Creek subwatershed, totaling 283 miles in length, for geologic mapping:

A map depicting the above listed streams is provided in Attachment A.

ADWR used a variety of techniques to select these watercourses including whether they showed signs of being intermittent or perennial, whether they would likely be intermittent or perennial absent human activity, and whether there was evidence of riparian growth, wetlands, or open water. This list of watercourses may change as ADWR and AZGS progress through their respective analyses.

II. Time Requirements

Upon receipt of the report and data from AZGS, ADWR estimates that it will require approximately 18 to 24 months to complete its analysis and proposed delineation of the subflow zone for the Silver Creek subwatershed. This is the same amount of time previously estimated for completion of a subflow delineation report for the LLCR subwatershed; however, ADWR would not be able to work on these reports simultaneously. ADWR proposes the following two scenarios for the Court's consideration:

Scenario 1- Starting with LLCR: If the Court requests that ADWR issue its subflow zone delineation report for the LLCR subwatershed first, ADWR could issue that report in

September 2025. Once that report is issued, ADWR could begin working on a subflow zone delineation report for the Silver Creek subwatershed with an expected publication date of September 2026. This projected timeline is based on the assumption that the two subflow zone technical reports would be published consecutively, and before the Preliminary Hydrographic Survey Report (PHSR) for the LLCR would be issued, as shown in Figure 1, below. Under this scenario, the PHSR would likely be issued in June 2028.

Scenario 2- Starting with Silver Creek: If the Court requests that ADWR issue its subflow zone delineation report for the Silver Creek subwatershed first, ADWR could issue that report in June 2024. Once that report is issued, ADWR could begin working on a subflow zone delineation report for the LLCR subwatershed with an expected publication date of March 2026. This projected timeline is based on the assumption that the two subflow zone technical reports would be published consecutively, and before the PHSR for the LLCR would be issued, as shown in Figure 2, below. Under this scenario, the PHSR would likely be issued in March 2028.
