Navajo County Assessor has identified as owned by the individuals listed on Attachment

A to this order. The first step in this case is an initial conference with the Court,

scheduled for Thursday, September 19, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.to determine if each

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landowner is interested in pursuing water rights claims. Each current landowner **MUST** attend the scheduled initial conference if they plan to pursue water rights claims. Failure to appear at the initial conference could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of potential surface water rights.

In this case, the United States Bureau of Land Management filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-84810 on June 5, 1985, to assert claims to use water on land that appears to comprise the Navajo County tax parcels listed on Attachment A to this order.

During the initial conference, each listed landowner Thursday, September 19, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. must state whether they intend to pursue a water rights claim.

Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment B.

Details of the Case

SOC 39-84810 contains a claim for a stockpond with a maximum volume of 2.6 acre-feet located in southwest-southeast-northeast Section 28, Township 12 North Range 23 East.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim and prepared Watershed File Report ("WFR") 33-51-023, published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("Silver Creek HSR"). The WFR recorded the existence of a stockpond within southeast-southwest-northeast Section 28, Township 12 North Range 23 East. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment C. A copy of a map displaying the area investigated by ADWR is attached as Attachment D.

After ADWR issued the WFR, an objection was filed to the findings made in the WFR by Salt River Project. The purpose of this case is to consider claims for water rights in SOC 39-84810 and to resolve the objections to WFR No. 33-51-023.

Claimant and Landowners

WFR 33-51-023 lists First American Title Insurance Company of Arizona as the owner of the property investigated in 1991. According to maps obtained from the Navajo County Assessor's ("Assessor") website, the land investigated appears to comprise the various Navajo County tax parcels listed on Attachment A to this order.

A copy of the map showing the relevant tax parcels and current ownership is attached as Attachment A. The public records of ADWR do not contain any assignments of the SOCs listed in the WFRs, and landowners do not appear to have filed any additional SOCs since the issuance of the 1991 HSR.

Objections

The objection to WFR 33-51-023 filed by Salt River Project is regarding the priority date claimed on the SOC. Pre adjudication documents which were filed to justify the basis or right for the proposed water rights are dated more recently than the SOC claims. To establish an older priority date, current property owners must present the Court with additional evidence of ongoing beneficial use since the dates claimed in the SOCs.

In order to obtain a decreed water right, a property owner must present to the Court an appropriate SOC claiming a water right in the name of the current property owner **and** evidence of that right. This evidence may include the relevant WFR. Alternatively, the property owners may settle with objectors. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of a water right on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an order from the Court, and all parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential surface water rights associated with the property

mentioned in this order. If you have questions regarding this Order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream Adjudication, Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can only answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Case Initiation. This order initiates contested case CV6417-33-5704. This case will resolve claims to use appropriable water asserted in Statement of Claimant 39-84810 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 033-51-023.
- 2. <u>Initial Conference</u>. An initial conference shall be held on **Thursday**, September 19, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. to determine whether each current landowner intends to pursue water rights claims. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment E. If you receive this Order by email, click on the red box "Join Court Connect Hearing" on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this Order by email, log into the Court Connect program on the internet by typing https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster. If you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 3. Parties. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants, the current landowners, and any party who filed objections to the Watershed File Report. The sole objector in this contested case is Salt River Project.
- 4. Objections. Copies of objections filed to this case can be found under the names and numbers the following website: respective on http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjud ication/whatsNew.asp.

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5. Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment F to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- E. Claimants who would like to receive courtesy copies of minute entries and orders may request inclusion on an email list by sending a request to emily.natale@jbazmc.maricopa.gov.



ATTACHMENT B

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels", groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Little Colorado River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.


